

CENTENNIAL HIGH SCHOOL CHIVALRY SCHOLARSHIP

The CHS Athletic Booster Association will present one scholarship to an outstanding female student/athlete and one scholarship to an outstanding male student/athlete at each year's annual Honors /Awards ceremony.

Each student/athlete shall be selected based on their academic knowledge, athletic achievements, and other extra-curricular activities at the high school or local community.

The student/athlete shall display outstanding leadership skills in his/her sport and amongst his/her student peers. The student/athlete shall have a strong character and act with integrity.

Nomination Criteria:

Student/athlete must have attended Centennial High School for 4 years.

Student/athlete must be a member of the senior class.

Student/athlete must have a minimum average grade of 90%.

Student/athlete must letter and participate in a GHSA sanctioned sport.

Student/athlete must be involved in other extra curricular activities at school or in the local community (e.g. student council, National Honor Society, yearbook, band orchestra, choir, drama club, French club, Habitat for Humanity, etc.)

Selection Criteria:

Varsity team coaches of each sport shall nominate up to two athletes based on the nomination criteria.

A list of nominated student/athletes shall be presented to the Athletic Director and the Principal for their review and concurrence.

The nominated student/athletes shall complete a short questionnaire summarizing their academic, athletic and community activities.

A selection committee shall review the questionnaires and if necessary conduct short interviews with the selected individual candidates.

The outstanding student/athlete shall be selected by majority vote of the selection committee.

Scholarship Amount:

The CHS Athletic Booster Association will award a \$2,000 scholarship to the outstanding female and male student athlete.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university the student athlete is attending in the fall semester, following graduation. In the event the student is awarded an additional or partial scholarship from the college, university or any other source the Chivalry Scholarship will be used to offset any balance. In the event the student athlete is awarded a full scholarship for the college, university or any other source, the Chivalry Scholarship will be forfeited and stay in the CHS Athletic Booster Association account. However, the student athlete will retain the honor. Money cannot be carried over to increase future scholarship awards.

Selection Committee:

The selection committee shall consist of the Principal, the Athletic Director, the CHS Athletic Booster Association President and two additional members chosen by the CHS Athletic Booster Association Board of Directors.
